## Official Organization Policies

### I. **Eligibility** - open to all males ages 12 – 19

- a. All members must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.
- b. All members must abide by the guidelines outlined below:

### II. **Guidelines**

#### **Attendance at weekly meetings**

- a. All members are expected and required to come to all meetings. If for some reason a member cannot make it to a meeting, he must report his upcoming absence to a mentor (Rodney Bohannon at 501-786-9309, Marquis Cooper at 901-786-2322, Marcus Heard at 501-563-5432, or Derrick Trahud at 501-772-7030).
- b. If a member misses **four** weekly meetings, they will be immediately put on probation status, and a meeting with the Mentors will be required to discuss the absences.
- c. If a member misses **six** weekly meetings, they will be dismissed from B.O.S.S.
- d. Any exceptions must be **pre-approved** by the Mentors.

#### **Academics**

- a. All members are required to maintain a 2.0 GPA.
  - i. During the school year, members will be required to bring or send a copy of their current quarterly report card to be kept on file.
  - ii. Report cards must be turned in within one week of the issue date.
- b. If a member's grades are below a 2.0 GPA, they will put on probation and not be allowed to participate in B.O.S.S. off-site activities or special events until their grades are above a 2.0 GPA.

#### **Behavior**

- a. All B.O.S.S. are expected to maintain the organization's high standard for excellent behavior as outlined in the B.O.S.S. principles document.
- b. A membership can be reviewed by the Mentors at any time due to failure of upholding the B.O.S.S. standards for excellent behavior.

- i. If the Mentors find it necessary, a member may be put on probation status for a set amount of time.
  - ii. At the end of the probation period, membership will be reviewed by the Mentors. As a result, a membership can be continued, or may be revoked.
- c. It is the responsibility of the B.O.S.S. to report any infraction to his mentor.

#### **Attendance at school**

- a. Members are to be in good-standing with any school attendance policy. If a member has more than **ten** absences from school, sign a behavior contract, write a reflective essay, and meet with the Mentors in order to continue coming to the weekly meetings.
- b. If a member misses more than **eleven** days of school, they can be dismissed from B.O.S.S.

#### **Attendance on the job (for employed members)**

- a. Members are to be in good-standing with their employer. If a member has more than **3 tardies and/or more than 3** absences from work within a 3 month period, the member will have to sign a behavior contract, write a reflective essay, and meet with the Mentors in order to continue coming to the weekly meetings.

#### **Activities Attendance**

- a. All members are required to participate in every B.O.S.S. fundraiser. If a member does not participate in a fundraiser, they will be unable to participate in the events held by B.O.S.S. If it is a repeated offense, they may be dismissed from B.O.S.S.
